BUILDING PERMIT GUIDELINES

One Building Permit can include one or more of the following projects when they are associated:

PERMIT REQUIRED

- 1. Any new structure built or assembled on the premise (including storage sheds).
- 2. Swimming pools, above ground and in ground.

§3109.4.1.9 Pool Structure as Barrier. Where an aboveground pool structure is used as a barrier or where the barrier is mounted on top of the pool structure, and the means of access is a ladder or steps, then the ladder or steps either shall be capable of being secured locked or removed to prevent access, or the ladder or steps shall be surrounded by a barrier which meets the requirements of §3109.4.1.1 through §3109.4.1.8. When the ladder or steps are secured, locked, or removed, any opening created shall not allow the passage of a 4-inch - diameter (102 mm) sphere.

- 3. Covered patio or car port. Decks more than 16" above ground.
- 4. Additions to building or major repairs
- 5. Alterations that change the use of the rooms in the building, especially if the
- 6. Major renovating requiring the disturbance of structural walls, plumbing and/or wiring.
- 7. Repairs to any house that has been condemned or that is in violation.
- 8. Installing new windows and/or doors of a larger size or where none previously existed, including skylights..
- 9. Any foundation or major repair of existing.
- 10. Chimneys and fireplaces.
- 11. Any multiple dwelling. Any commercial building doing residential apartments.

- 12. Demolition of structures or removal of building components such as a porch.
- 13. Replacement of building components when changing the size or location.
- 14. Fences all kinds.
- 15. Any construction in the designated flood plain area, including fill.
- 16. Signs
- 17. Any Roof replacement (including shingles)

PERMIT NOT REQUIRED

- 1. Siding repair or replacement. Note: Water Department <u>must</u> be notified to remove reader.
- 2. Driveways. Note: A curb cut is needed for new or wider entrances to the road.
- 3. Uncovered patio. Decks below 16" above ground.
- 4. Installation of cabinets, paneling, plaster, plasterboard, and trim on existing walls.
