

VILLAGE ELECTION

Wednesday, March 18, 2026

A General Election of the Village of Waverly will be held on Wednesday, March 18, 2026, at the Waverly Village Hall, 32 Ithaca Street, Waverly, NY, between the hours of 12:00 noon and 9:00 p.m.

The following are to be elected:

TRUSTEE: Two-year term, office now held by John Kevin Sweeney

TRUSTEE: Two-year term, office now held by Courtney Aronstam

TRUSTEE: Two-year term, office now held by Michael Gorman

TRUSTEE: One-year term, office now held by Lyman Wage

TRUSTEE: One-year term, office is currently vacant

November 17, 2025 is the first day the Clerk may accept absentee ballot applications.

December 30, 2025 is the first date that individuals may sign independent nominating petitions.

February 3, 2026 is the first day to file an independent nominating petition.

February 10, 2026 is the ***LAST*** day an Independent Nominating Petition to be on the ballot can be filed with the Village Clerk (8:30 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.) at 32 Ithaca Street, Waverly, NY.

*Petitions must have a minimum of 75 qualified signatures. A qualified signatory must be a registered voter who resides in the Village of Waverly.

March 6, 2026 is the last day individuals may register with Tioga County Board of Elections to be eligible to vote in the Village Election.
