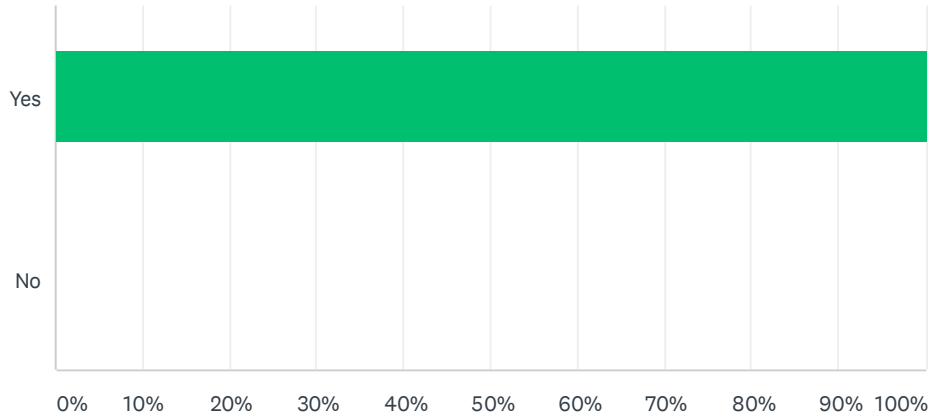


Q1 Do you attend school in the Waverly Central School District or have you ever interacted with a member of the Waverly Police Department?

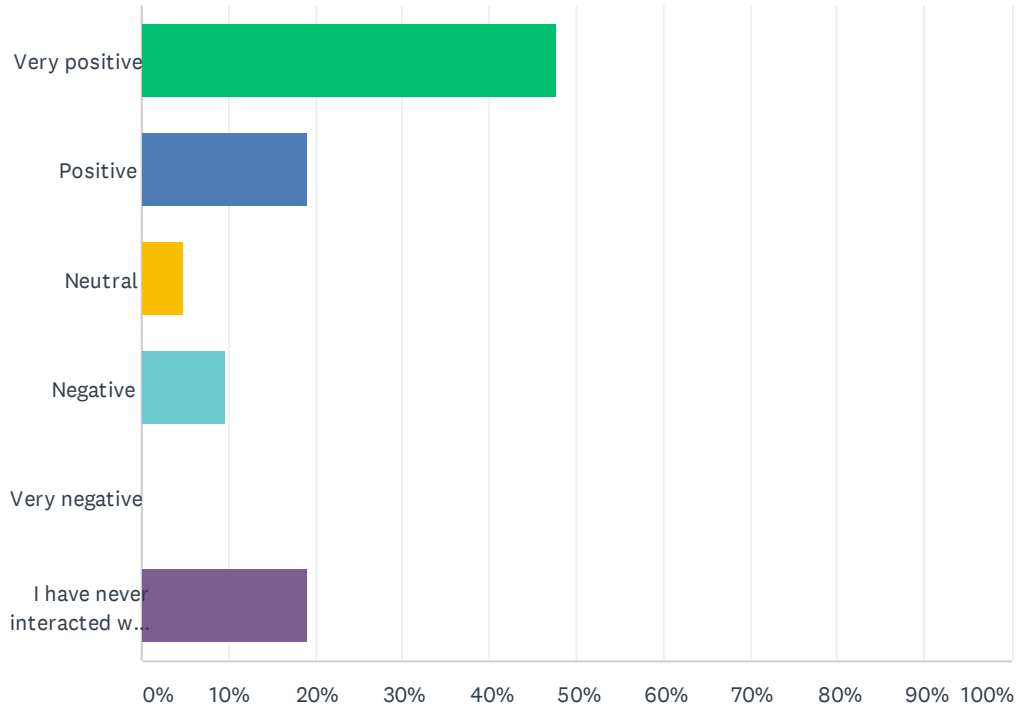

Q2 How would you describe your interactions with the Waverly Police Department?

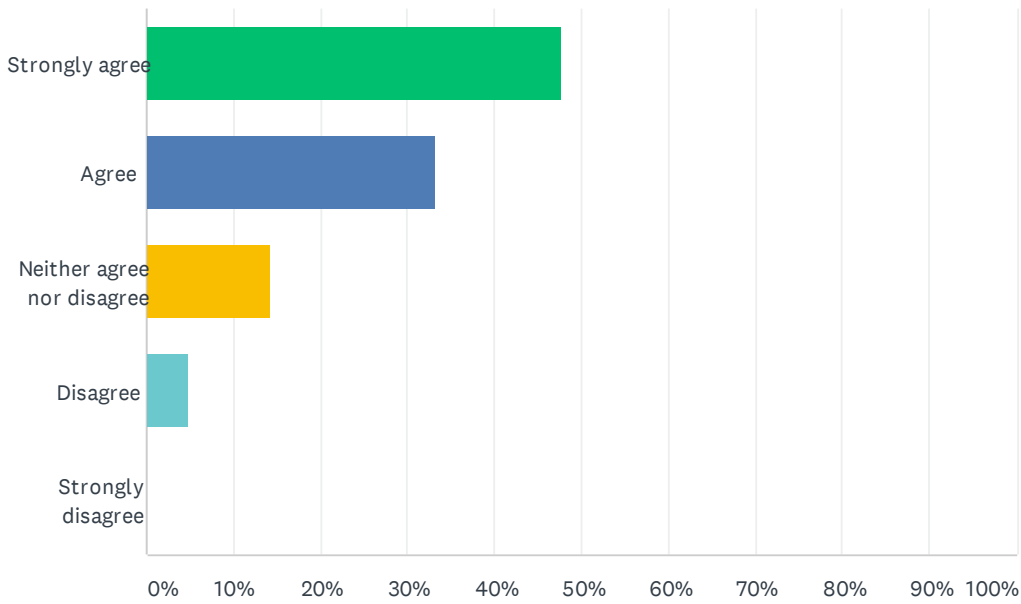

Q3 How do you feel about the following statement: "The Waverly Police Department helps keep our school district safe"

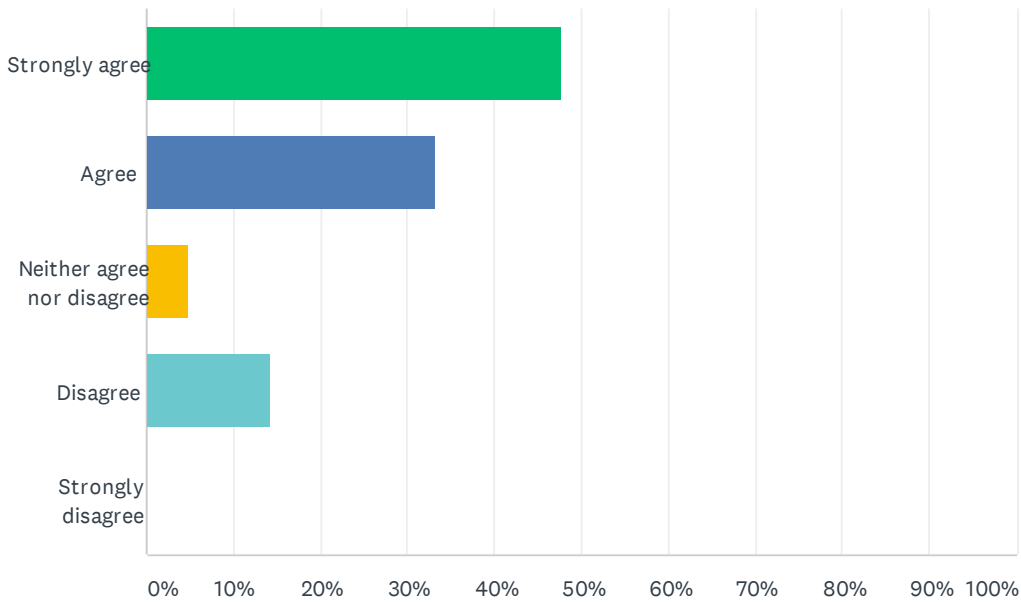

Q4 How do you feel about the following statement: "The Waverly Police Department treats people from all walks of life with fairness"

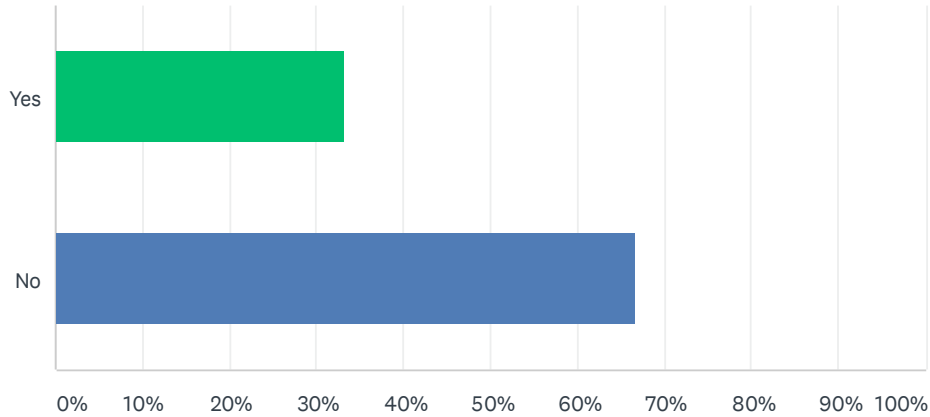

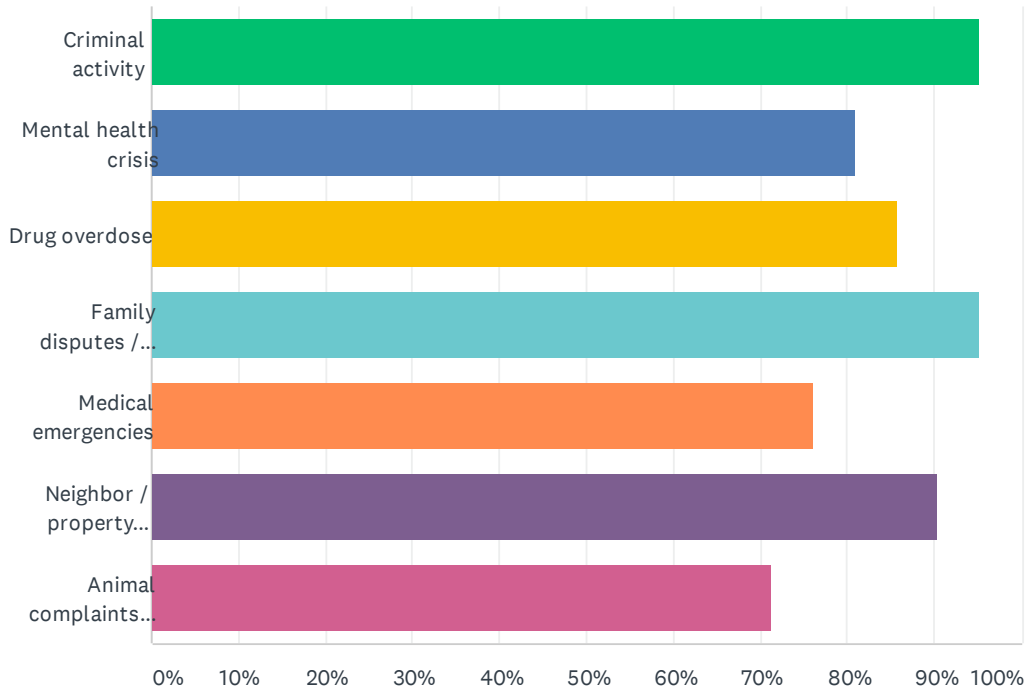
